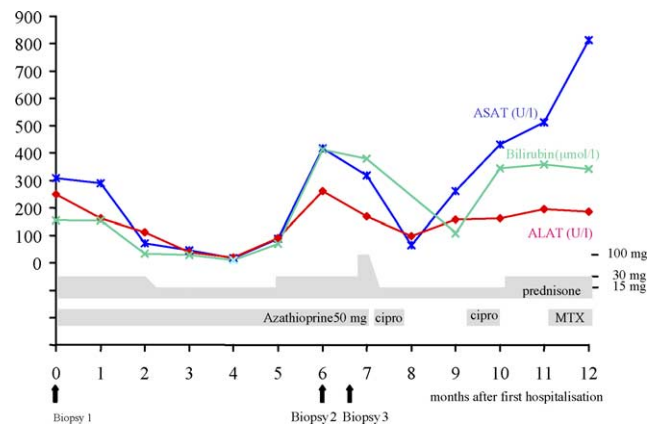


Fig. 1. Changes of ASAT (U/l), ALAT (U/l) and bilirubin ($\mu\text{mol/l}$) during the months after the first hospitalisation in relation to the medication used. Prednisone was given in dosages varying from 15 to 100 mg/day, azathioprine was given 50 mg/day, ciprofloxacin 2×500 mg/day and methotrexate 15 mg/week. Cipro = ciprofloxacin, MTX = methotrexate, ASAT = aspartate aminotransferase, ALAT = alanine aminotransferase.

The Publisher regrets that in the above Letter to the Editor an error occurred in the printed version of Fig. 1. The correct Fig. 1 is printed below.
